PURPOSE OF MEETING WITH AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS

The purpose of tonight's Meeting with Affected Property Owners (MAPO) is to present the proposed minor design modification that is under consideration since the Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) and Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) issued an FEIS in August 2008 and to receive public comment. Tonight's meeting will primarily focus on the proposed modification that occurs along the Preferred Alternative Alignment for approximately two miles between the crossings of FM 2920 and Kuykendahl Road; however, comments regarding any other features of proposed SH 99, Grand Parkway Segment F-2 are appreciated as well.

Proposed minor design modifications for Segment F-2 involve a slight shift in the Preferred Alternative Alignment between FM 2920 and Kuykendahl Road near the subdivisions of Willow Trace and Lakes of Avalon Village. This minor shift in alignment is in response to public comment and is intended to reduce impacts in the proposed project area. Other than that which has been proposed above, no additional design modifications for Segment F-2 are currently under consideration.

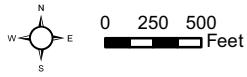

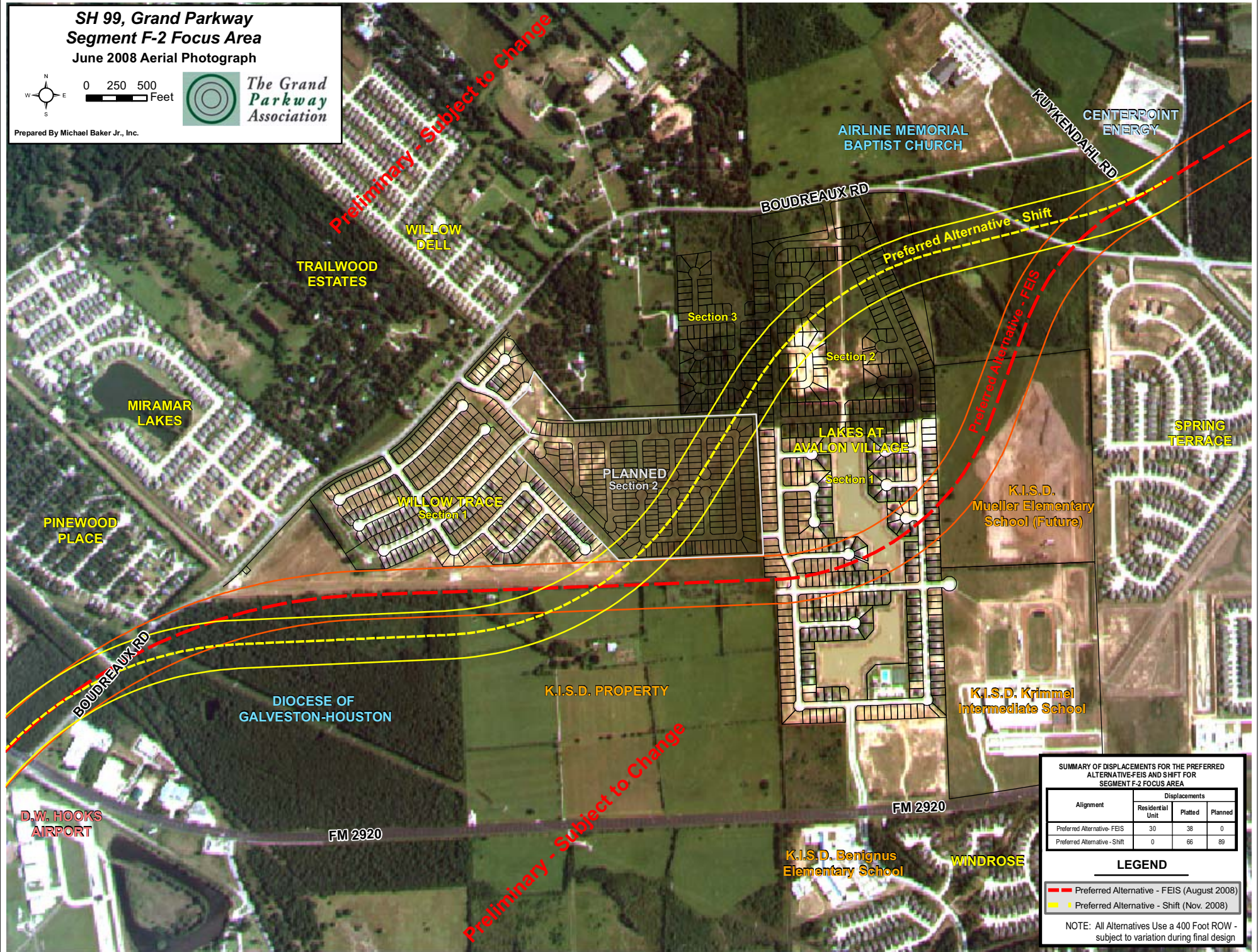
