

NOTICE OF MEETING WITH AFFECTED PROPERTY OWNERS

The Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) will conduct a Meeting with Affected Property Owners concerning proposed minor design modifications to SH99, SH 249 to IH 45, the Grand Parkway Segment F-2. The proposed modifications occur along the Preferred Alignment for approximately two miles between the crossings of FM 2920 and Kuykendahl Road. The purpose of this meeting is to present proposed minor design modifications that are under consideration since TxDOT and the Federal Highway Administration issued a Final Environmental Impact Study in August 2008, and to receive public comment on these or other features of Segment F-2.

Who: The Texas Department of Transportation invites all persons to attend

What: The meeting with Affected Property Owners will be an Open House format with no formal presentation. You are encouraged to attend and provide your input.

Proposed minor design modifications for Segment F-2 involve a slight shift in the Preferred Alignment between FM 2920 and Kuykendahl Road near the subdivisions of Willow Trace and Lakes of Avalon Village. This minor shift in alignment is in response to public comment and is intended to reduce impacts in the proposed project area. Other than that proposed above, no additional design modifications for Segment F-2 are currently under consideration.
